Easter Blessings

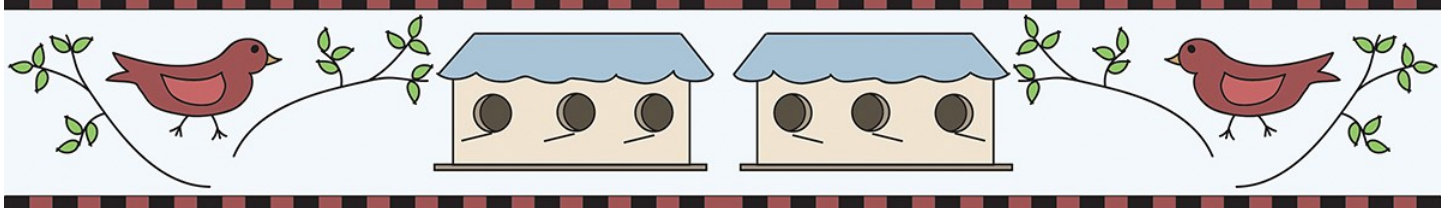
