And zoom without care.

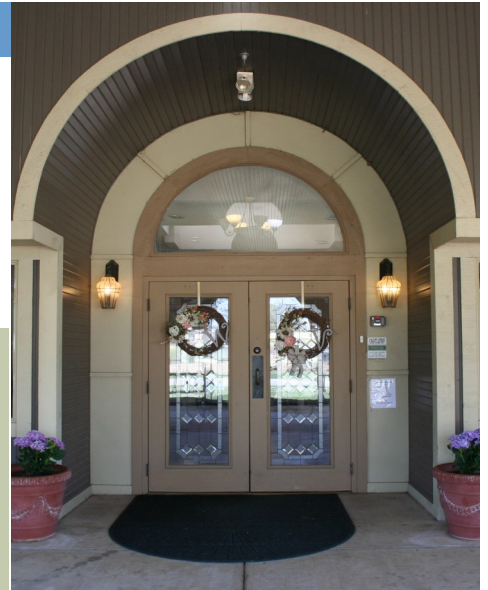
May days grow hot.
