Fill it with musky and largemouth bass, walleye and northern pike.

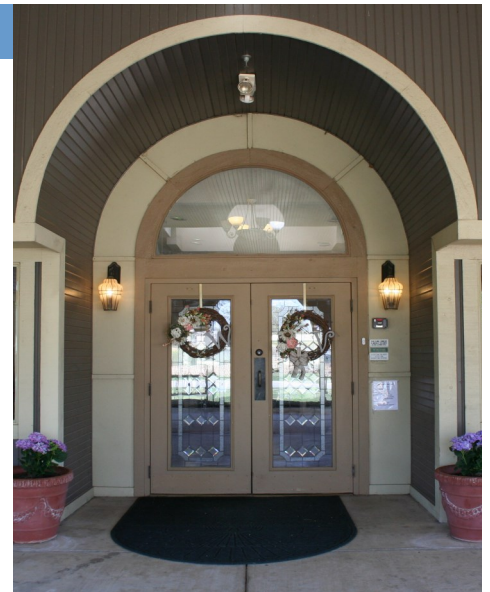
Add pairs of loons, warbling their mournful cry, graceful herons, still as

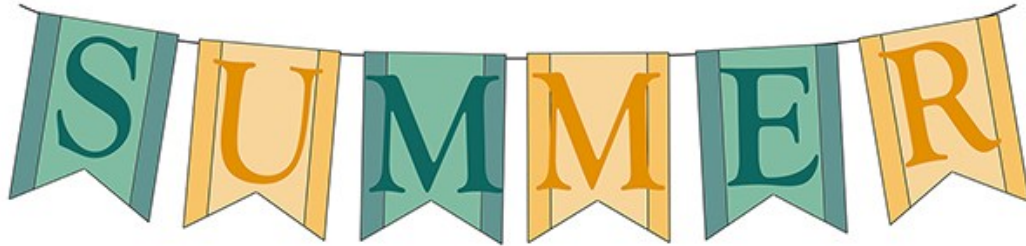
