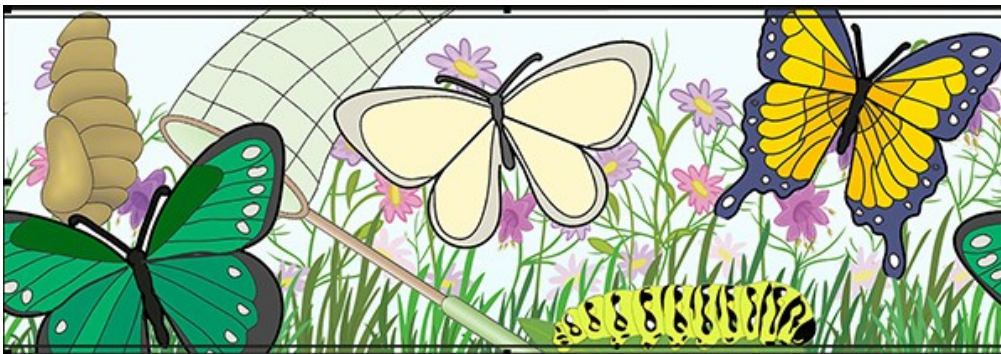
June

as nighttime slips away.

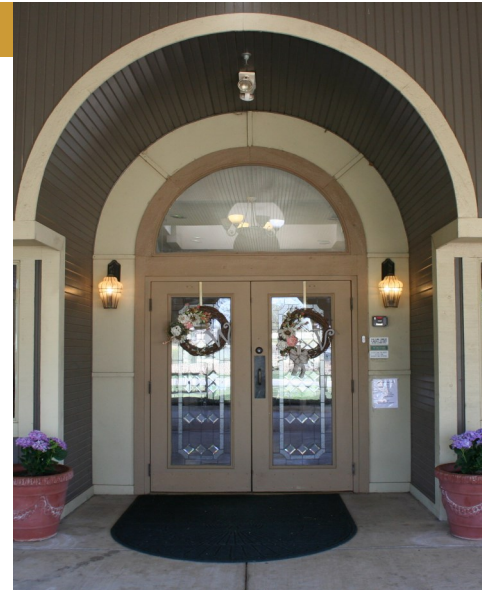
Dewdrops sparkling in the sun

The annual migration of North America's monarch butterfly is a unique and amazing marvel. The monarch is the only butterfly known to make a two-way migration as birds do. Unlike other butterflies that can overwinter in some species, monarchs cannot survive the cold winters of northern climates. Using environmental cues, the monarchs know when it is time to travel south for the winter. Monarchs use a combination of air currents and thermals to travel long distances. Some fly as far as 3,000 miles to reach their winter home!
